1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.
2. The applicant who is in custody since 15.07.2024 has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail in connection with Burmamines P.S. Case No.44 of 2024, registered for the offence under Sections 103(1), 238, 61(2), 3(5) of B.N.S., 2023 and Section 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the court of learned J.M. 1st Class, Jamshedpur.
3. Earlier the prayer for bail of the applicant had been rejected by this Court vide order dated 25.09.2025 passed in B.A. No.8447 of 2025.
4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.
5. Innocence has been claimed by the learned counsel for the applicant and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that only material available against this applicant that a dead body has been found in the house of the applicant. Further, it has been submitted that charge has been framed on 19.03.2025 and till date only six charge sheeted witnesses have been examined out of twelve charge sheeted witnesses. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.
6. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
7. Considering the above facts and the period of custody, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of

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the learned J.M. 1st Class, Jamshedpur in connection with Burmamines P.S. Case No.44 of 2024, subject to condition that the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy/photocopies of his/her/their Aadhaar Card(s) and also submit his/her/their mobile number(s) before the trial court which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
