Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the same.

W.P.(S) No. 2600 of 2016

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner superannuated in the year, 2015, but the respondent have not made any payments towards the retrial benefits.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents submits that since the departmental proceeding is pending against the petitioner and he has not appeared before the Inquiry Officer and as such, amount of the retrial benefits have not been released.

Nothing has been brought on record, when the departmental proceeding was initiated against the petitioner and what was the charges levelled against the petitioner.

Under such circumstances, the respondents are directed to file a specific affidavit mentioning therein whether the departmental proceedings was initiated after retirement or prior to his retirement and whether the procedures have been adopted for initiating departmental proceeding or not ?
