1. Heard the parties.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that a name of one Anchit Ram Upadhyay has been wrongly entered in Register-II against the land pertaining to Plot No.359, contained in Khata No.03, Mouza Maltoli, measuring an area of 1.17 Acres, Register-II at page No.-3, Part-1, which according to the petitioner belongs to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has filed a detailed representation before the Circle Officer who is respondent No.3 but no action has been taken.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that if the petitioner files a fresh representation, the same will be considered and after going through the records and documents, an appropriate order would be passed by the Circle Officer-Respondent No.3. He further submits that if it is found that the name of Anchit Ram Upadhyay has been erroneously entered, the correction would be made.
5. Considering the said submission, I direct the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of four weeks from today, before the respondent No.3 who will hear the petitioner and will also hear Anchit Ram Upadhyay whose name has been wrongly entered in the Register-II and thereafter, considering the records and the documents furnished by the parties and available with the respondents, will pass an appropriate order on the representation.

6. It is expected that the respondents after hearing all the parties, will pass a reasoned order, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of appearance of both the parties before the respondent No.3 and communicate the order to them.

7. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition stands **disposed of.**
