counsel for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with  
Mirzachouki P.S. Case No. 47 of 2025, registered under sections 316(5),  
319(2), 318(4) and 61 (2) of the BNS, 2023, pending in the Court of learned  
S.D.J.M, Sahibganj.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner  
has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioner  
was not provided stock register relating to foodgrains kept in the Jharkhand  
State Food Corporation, Sahibganj at the time of taking of charge and in view  
of that the petitioner may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits  
that allegations are there of black-marketing of foodgrains of 1202.4044  
quintals amounting to Rs. 48,09,617.60.

5. The allegation against the petitioner is of black-marketing of  
foodgrains of 1202.4044 quintals amounting to Rs. 48,09,617.60. In the  
order of the learned Sessions Judge, it has come that the witnesses  
examined in paras 8, 9 and 10 of the case diary have supported the case  
of prosecution of shortage of foodgrains.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am not
