1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made a representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure-3) to the respondent No. 3 seeking the same reliefs as are sought for in this writ petition. On instructions, he submits that for the present, the petitioner would be satisfied, if some time bound directions are issued to the respondent No. 3 to dispose of the petitioner's representation in accordance with law and on its own merits.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner's representation dated 19.05.2025 will be disposed of by the respondent No. 3 within eight weeks from today after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and after that, by passing a reasoned order.
4. The above statement made by learned counsel for the respondents is accepted.

7. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms without any order for costs.
