Heard the learned counsel for the respective sides.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of the Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that out of a sentence of six month S.I., the petitioner in total has remained in custody for a period of four months twenty days. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has already extended an amount of Rs. 2,78,000/- out of a total cheque amount of Rs. 7 Lakhs. It has also been stated that if the matter is listed after two months, the petitioner shall submit a demand draft amounting to Rs. 2,22,000/- drawn in favour of the opposite party No. 2.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer made by the petitioner in this application.

Considering the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner has completed a substantial part of the sentence, I am inclined to accede to the prayer made by the petitioner in this application. Consequently, the petitioner is exempted to surrender in connection with Complaint Case No. 94 of 2020.

I.A. stands disposed of.

Issue notice to the opposite party No. 2 as to why this application shall not be admitted and/or disposed of at the admission stage itself for

which requisite etc. under speed post as well as by ordinary process must be filed by 11.06.2026.

It is expected that on the next date of listing, the learned counsel for the petitioner shall produce a demand draft amounting to Rs. 2,22,000/- drawn in favour of the opposite party No. 2 as has been undertaken by him and which has been recorded earlier.
