2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Saraikela PS Case No.98 of 2025, for offence registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 324(4), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023, pending in court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, at Saraikela Kharsawan.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that altercation took place due to parking of the vehicle. He next submits that the petitioner was having apprehension and in view of that, the petitioner has approached the police station and intimated by way of Annexure-2 on 08.10.2025 and the alleged occurrence is said to be of 11.10.2025 whereas the FIR was registered on 12.10.2025

and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.10.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that the allegation of assault is there.

5. Considering that the petitioner has approached the police station and intimated by way of Annexure-2 on 08.10.2025 and the alleged occurrence is said to be of 11.10.2025 whereas the FIR was registered on 12.10.2025 and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.10. In that view of the matter, the petitioner, above named, is, hereby, directed to surrender before learned court within two weeks from today, and learned court shall release the petitioner, above named, on such terms and conditions as well as sureties as the learned court may deem fit and proper.

6. This petition is disposed of.
