The grievance of the petitioner is that, though she is the daughter-in-law of the concerned village where the Aanganbadi center is situated, but the respondents have not appointed her on the ground that she belongs to another village.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that there is one separate notification whereby the said village has been demarcated. However, he fairly admits that the same paragraph has not been incorporated in the counter-affidavit, but certainly the demarcation was taken much prior to the filing of the counter-affidavit.

3. It is very unfortunate for the deponents, who are signing an affidavit before the High Cour, fail to furnish correct and up- to- date information to their counsel. This being the reason there is a delay in disposing of small petty matters, this is very unfortunate and accordingly the respondent is directed to file a supplementary counter-affidavit showing about the demarcation.
