The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the appellant for suspension of sentence and for confirmation of the provisional bail granted to the appellant vide order dated 29.01.2019 passed by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Giridih, in connection with S.T. No. 64 of 2017.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in pursuance of conviction and sentence of the appellant by the learned trial court, he was granted provisional bail vide order dated 29.01.2019 under Section 389(3) Cr.P.C. for one month for preferring the present appeal before this Court. Subsequently, vide order dated 01.03.2019, the provisional bail granted to the appellant by the learned trial court was extended by a Bench of this Court till today i.e., 06.03.2019.

Having heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned A.P.P., the sentence awarded to the appellant by the learned trial court shall remain suspended during the pendency of the present appeal.

Accordingly, the provisional bail granted to the appellant by the learned trial court vide order dated 29.01.2019 is hereby confirmed.
