OP No.2 passed in ABA No.4956 of 2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the
basis of the compromise the anticipatory bail was granted to the OP
No.2 however the terms and conditions of the said anticipatory bail
are not being fulfilled by the OP No.2 and in view of that,
anticipatory bail may kindly be cancelled.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that on the baiss
of compromise the anticipatory bail was allowed.

4. On the basis of the compromise between the petitioner
and the OP No.2 the anticipatory bail was allowed and there are

criteria of cancellation of bail once granted, and those are, as under:

“(i) the accused misuses his liberty by indulging in similar criminal activity,
(ii) interferes with the course of investigation,
(iii) attempts to tamper with evidence or witnesses,
(iv) threatens witnesses or indulges in similar activities which would hamper smooth investigation,
(v) there is likelihood of his fleeing to another country,
(vi) attempts to make himself scarce by going underground or becoming unavailable to the investigating agency,
(vii) attempts to place himself beyond the reach of his surety, etc.”

5. Only on the cogent reasons, once the bail granted, can be cancelled. The said anticipatory bail was granted on the basis of compromise and no case for cancellation of anticipatory bail to OP No.2 is made out.

6. As such, this Cr.M.P.No.1235 of 2026 is hereby dismissed.
