The order dated 10.03.2022 passed in W.P.(S) No.3012 of 2021, has not yet been complied with, though several opportunities were given for compliance of the same.

2. The aforesaid attitude of the opposite parties suggests that their action is willful and deliberate.

3. Issue notice of contempt to opposite party Nos.2 & 3 by speed post as well as by ordinary process, for which requisites etc., must be filed within two weeks, as to why not charge be framed against them for non-compliance of the Court's order. They should remain present in person before this Court on the next date to explain as to why not charge be framed against them.

4. The copy of the order will be communicated to opposite party Nos.2 & 3 along with the notice.

5. The petitioner is directed to implead the Accountant General, Jharkhand, as opposite party No.4.

6. Necessary corrections be made in the cause title of this contempt case, during the course of the day.

7. List this case after two weeks.
