Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents.

2. It is the grievance of the petitioner that name of mother of the petitioner has been wrongly recorded in the Marksheet/Certificate (2022) and all the Certificates issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education for Class-X.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of mother of the petitioner is "**Sunaina Sahu**", but in the marksheet and certificate of Class-10 of C.B.S.E examination it has been typed as "Sunita Sahu", though the correct name as "**Sunaina Sahu**" has been recorded in Class-12 marksheet and certificate by the examining authority i.e. C.B.S.E. He also submits that even in the transfer certificate of Class-10 the correct name of mother of the petitioner has been printed as "**Sunaina Sahu**", which is correct.

4. The grievance of the petitioner is that vide Annexure-4 the Principal of the school has forwarded a request to the Regional Office

of C.B.S.E, Patna, but C.B.S.E has not taken any action.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of C.B.S.E. submits that the C.B.S.E. will consider the application of the petitioner and will do the needful at the earliest.

6. Consider the said submission, I direct the petitioner to approach the In-charge of the Regional Office of C.B.S.E, Patna along with all the documents along with the copy of the letter of Principal of Delhi Public School Greater Ranchi. On receipt of the same, within four weeks from today, the Central Board of Secondary Education, Patna will take appropriate steps and make necessary correction and issue fresh corrected Marksheet/Certificate and other Certificates to the petitioner.

7. The entire process should be completed within a period of 10 (ten) weeks from the date of receipts of a copy of this order along with the fresh representation filed by the petitioner.

8. With this observation and direction, this writ petition stands disposed of.

9. Pending, I.A., if any, stands disposed of.
