Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Karmatanr P.S. Case No.117 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 310(2) of the B.N.S., 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner committed dacoity and looted cash, gold and silver jewelries. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false. It is then submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that, as mentioned in para-10 of the counter affidavit, filed on behalf of the State, it has categorically been mentioned that Test Identification Parade has not been conducted even though the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. It is next submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 23.12.2025, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 11 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the above-named

petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Jamtara, in connection with Karmatanr P.S. Case No.117 of 2025 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
