Heard Mr. Ajit Kumar Jha, learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioners
for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the High
Court of Jharkhand Rules, 2001.

The reason which has been assigned in the instant application is
that both the petitioners are students and if they are taken into custody,
they will have to discontinue their studies.

Mere mention has been made about the petitioner no. 2 appearing
in the intermediate examination of the year 2025. So far as petitioner no.
1 is concerned, nothing has been mentioned regarding the studies
undergoing by him and so far as the petitioner no. 2 is concerned, he has
already appeared in the intermediate examination as mentioned in
paragraph 6 of the instant application.

There being no reason to grant exemption to the petitioners, this
application is rejected.

I.A. No. 9273 of 2025 stands rejected.
