2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sakchi PS Case No.219 of 2023 (G.R.Case No.171 of 2024), for offence registered under section 399 and 402 of Indian Penal Code and section 25(1-A)/26/35 of Arms Act, pending in court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamshedpur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case on the confessional statement of other co-accused. He next submits that the only allegation against petitioner is made of planning with other co-accused persons to commit crime and he next submits that crime has not been committed as yet. He next submits that one criminal antecedent is there against the petitioner under section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act. He also submits that arms have been recovered from the apprehended co-accused.
4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement.
5. Considering that the name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement and the one case is pending against the petitioner under section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and the arms have been recovered from the possession of the apprehended co-accused, and in that view of the matter, the petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender before learned court within two weeks from today, and learned court shall release petitioner, above named, on such terms and conditions as well as sureties as learned court may deem fit and proper. This petition is disposed of.
