Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Sukhdeo Nagar P.S. Case No.594 of 2025 (N) (NDPS Case No. 02 of 2026) registered for the offences punishable under sections 21(b)/22/29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner and the co-accused person were in illegal possession of 28.59 grams of brown sugar which is also known as *Heroin* and out of which 22.05 grams of brown sugar was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the alleged contraband comes under intermediate quantity. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as has been mentioned in paragraph no.16 of the bail application. It is then submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 01.11.2025, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 18 of the bail application and charge sheet has been submitted in this case but no witnesses have been examined as yet. It is next submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during

the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the abovenamed petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Commissioner, Ranchi, in connection with Sukhdeo Nagar P.S. Case No.594 of 2025 (N) (NDPS Case No. 02 of 2026) with the condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and a copy of his Aadhar Card in the court below with the undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
