02/24.04.2026 The present Cr.M.P. has been filed for modification of
order dated 29.01.2026 passed in A.B.A. No. 447 of 2026.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by order
dated 29.01.2026 passed in A.B.A. No. 447 of 2026 the petitioner
was provided privilege of anticipatory bail, however, the petitioner
has not been able to surrender before the learned court within the
stipulated period due to ailment. To buttress this argument, he refers
to Annexure-2 which is a prescription of doctor.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that the anticipatory
bail was already provided to the petitioner in spite of that the
petitioner has not surrendered.

4. Considering that the anticipatory bail was already provided
to the petitioner, however, the petitioner has not been able to
surrender before the learned Court due to the reason pointed out by
the learned counsel for the petitioner and Annexure-2 is a document

which prima facie suggests that the petitioner is having some ailment, as such further two weeks' time from today is extended to surrender before the learned Court.

5. Order dated 29.01.2026 passed in A.B.A. No. 447 of 2026 is modified to the above extent.

6. Rest of the order is kept intact.

7. This Cr.M.P. is disposed of.
