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02/ 25.03.2026: This bail application has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 483 & 484 of BNSS, 2023 wherein, prayer has been made for grant of bail as he is in custody for allegedly committing offence punishable under Sections 108(3) and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Sanhita.

2. Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and have also gone through the impugned order.

3. Learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

4. There was some intimacy between the petitioner and the deceased. The deceased committed suicide in her own house. It is stated that before committing suicide there was some telephonic conversation between them. Note was found after the death wherein it was written as "*Mere Marne Ke Bad Sirf Ek Kam Kar Dena Bas Farhan Khan Ke Hath Se Pani Dena*". These are only material available against this petitioner.

5. Considering the nature of evidence collected during investigation, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the

learned A.C.J.M., Latehar, in connection with Garu P.S. Case No.33 of 2025, subject to the condition that one of the bailors should be a close relative of the petitioner, having sufficient landed property in his/her own name within the State of Jharkhand.
