2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sudamdih P.S. Case No.30 of 2025 for the alleged offences registered under Sections 85, 115(2), 126(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law respectively and

there are general and omnibus allegation of torture and demand of dowry.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State and Informant vehemently opposed the prayer and submits that allegations are there of torture and demand of dowry.

Considering that petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law respectively and there are general and omnibus allegation of torture and demand of dowry and in that view of the matter the petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioners on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
