Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody since 24.12.2025 in connection with Korrah P.S. Case No. 230 of 2025 for the offences registered under Sections 317/319/318/338/340/61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and 66C / 66D of the I.T. Act, pending in the court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Hazaribagh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case and the petitioners are in custody since 24.12.2025. He has further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in paragraph no. 6 of the bail application. He has also submitted that as such no witnesses have been identified. He has further submitted that today is the date fixed before the learned court for the purposes of framing of charges. He further submits that similarly situated co-accused persons have been enlarged on bail today itself in B.A. 2200 of 2026 namely Nakka Shiva @ N. Shiva.

4. Learned counsel for the opposite party-State has opposed the prayer. However, he does not dispute the aforesaid submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and the petitioners are in custody since 24.12.2025, the petitioners above named are directed to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Hazaribagh in connection with Korrah P.S. Case No. 230 of 2025 on the following conditions:

- (i) One of the bailors would be the present *pairvikar* of the petitioners.
- (ii) The other bailor should be his close relative.
- (iii) The petitioners will attend the court on each and every date and on account of their single default, the learned court shall cancel the bail bond furnished by the petitioners.
- (iv) The petitioners will deposit a self-attested copy of his Aadhar Card along with his mobile number before the learned court which he will not change during the pendency of the case without prior permission of the court.
- (v) The petitioners shall fully co-operate with the proceedings before the learned court below.

6. Let this order along with a copy of the affidavit filed with the bail petition be communicated to the court concerned through FAX/e-mail.

7. The instant bail application is allowed with the aforesaid conditions.

8. The case of the co-accused is listed on 13.05.2026 of that of Sachin Kumar in B.A. No. 2380 of 2026. The office is directed to place the case diary in the said case.
