**2.** The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with  
Jamtara Cyber Crime P.S. Case No.11 of 2025 for the alleged  
offences registered under Sections 111(2)(ii), 317(2), 318(4),  
319(2), 336(3), 338, 340(2) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,  
2023 and Sections 66(B)(C)(D) of I.T. Act pending in the Court of  
learned Special Judge, Cyber Crime, Jamtara.

**3.** Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that  
the petitioner has earlier moved before this Court in ABA No.2756 of  
2025 which was dismissed as withdrawn. He further submits that on  
the fresh ground second anticipatory bail application has been filed.

**4.** Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer  
and submits that what has been stated in the petition that ground  
was already there in spite of that the petitioner has withdrawn

earlier ABA No.2756 of 2025. She further submits that there is no ground to entertain the second anticipatory bail application.

**5.** The case is arising out of the cyber-crime and the petitioner has already withdrawn the ABA No.2756 of 2025 and no fresh ground has been argued to entertain the second anticipatory bail application, as such the present anticipatory bail application is hereby dismissed.
