as the learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Simariya P.S. Case No.95 of 2025 for the alleged offences registered
under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352 and
3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the Court of
learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the
petitioner is aged about 70 years. He further submits that due to
land dispute altercation took place and the entire family members
have been made accused. He then submits that there are general
and omnibus allegation against all the family members. He next
submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as

disclosed in paragraph No.15 of the petition.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that allegations are there and injury has also been received.

5. Considering that the petitioner is aged about 70 years and it has been pointed out that altercation took place due to land dispute and the entire family members have been made accused and there are general and omnibus allegation against all the family members and it is not clear that from whose blow such injury has been received by one Ritu Yadav and in that view of the matter the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
