2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Telaiya P.S. Case No. 34 of 2026, registered for the offence under
Sections 272, 274, 275, 292, 318(4) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya
Sanhita, 2023 and Section 47(a)(f) of Jharkhand Excise Act, pending in
the court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Koderma.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the allegations are made that 220 liters of mahua liquor has been
recovered from the house of the petitioner. He next submits that the
house, from which, the seizure has been made was in dilapidated
condition and petitioner is not residing there, rather he is residing in
newly built house. He further submits that the petitioner is having no
criminal antecedent and disclosure to that effect has been made in para-
14 of the petition.

4. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has opposed the
prayer and submits that the petitioner happened to be the owner of the
said house.

5. Annexure-2 of the petition is the certificate issued by the Jhumri Telaiya Nagar Parishad, wherein it has been disclosed that since 2012, the petitioner is not residing in the said house and further the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent and disclosure to that effect has been made in para-14 of the petition, in that view of the matter, the petitioner, named above, is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
