1. Heard the parties.
2. It is the grievance of the petitioners that though in the physical register, name of forefathers of this petitioner was recorded but in the online entry, the land has not been recorded in the name of the actual holder in consonance with the physical register.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that suffice it would be if a direction is given to the respondent No.4, the Circle Officer, Govindpur Circle, Dhanbad, to do the needful.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that if the petitioner file a representation before respondent No.4, his case will be considered and if it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him.
5. Considering the said submission, I direct the petitioner to file a representation before respondent No.4, within four weeks.

On receipt of the said representation, the case of the petitioner will be considered by the respondent No.4 within a period of six weeks, after hearing all the parties concerned. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within two weeks thereafter.

6. With the aforesaid observations, this writ petition stands **disposed of**.
