2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 378 of 2017, registered for the offence under Sections 498A, 494 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Lohardaga.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner happens to be the husband of the informant and false allegation is made against the petitioner of marrying the second lady in the complaint case. He further submits that the petitioner has not married with another lady and the complaint has been lodged after 30 years of marriage between the petitioner and the informant.

4. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has opposed the prayer and submits that the case arise out of complaint case.

5. Considering that the case arise out of complaint case and the petitioner happens to be husband and the second marriage has been denied by the petitioner and the complaint case has been lodged after 30 years of marriage between the petitioner and the informant, and in that view of the matter, the petitioner, named above, is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
