2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No.28949 of 2025, for the alleged offences
registered under Rule 54 of Jharkhand Minor Mineral Concession
Rules, 2004, Rule 9/11 of Jharkhand Minerals (Prevention of Illegal
Mining Transportation and Storage) Rule, 2017 and Section 4/21 of
Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, pending
in the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is the owner-cum-driver of the Tractor and the
allegations are made that 100 cft. sand was being carried in the
said tractor. He further submits that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.8 of the petition.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that allegations are there of illegally carrying the sand.

5. Considering that the petitioner is the owner-cum-driver of the Tractor and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.8 of the petition and in that view of the matter the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
