Heard learned counsel appearing for the appellant and learned APP appearing for State.

This application has been preferred by the appellant renewing his prayer for grant of bail to the appellant during the pendency of this appeal.

The appellant appears to have been convicted for the offences u/s 25(1-B)a, 26(1), 25(1-A)/ 35 and 26(2)/35 of the Arms Act and had been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for six years. The appellant appears to be in custody since 05.12.2017 and has almost completed half of the sentence imposed upon him.

On consideration of the aforesaid facts, the appellant is directed to be released on bail during pendency of this appeal, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court [Additional Sessions Judge-II, Latehar] in connection with Sessions Trial No. 168 of 2018.

I.A. No. 3237 of 2020 stands allowed and disposed of.
