The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the appellant under Section 389(1) Cr.P.C. for suspension of sentence and for confirmation of the provisional bail granted to the appellant vide order dated 08.02.2019 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, West Singhbhum at Chaibasa, in connection with S.T. No. 152 of 2018.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that after conviction and sentence of the appellant, he has been granted provisional bail by the learned trial court vide order dated 08.02.2019 for 60 days to prefer an appeal before this Court.

Having heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned A.P.P., the sentence awarded to the appellant by the learned trial court vide order dated 08.02.2019 shall remain suspended during the pendency of the present appeal.
