2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aggrieved by the order of transfer from Battalion-174 to Battalion-073 Srinagar. She submits that the petitioner has hardly one year of his service.
3. The learned ASGI by referring to transfer order dated 18.03.2026 submits that the case of the petitioner has been considered and he has been retained till his superannuation in Battalion-174. He hands over the copy of the aforesaid communication to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The same is kept on record.
4. Considering the fact that the petitioner has been retained till superannuation in Battalion-174, the grievance of the petitioner is already redressed.
5. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of.
