He prays that a direction be issued to decide the objection.

Considering the limited prayer made by the petitioner, I direct the respondent No.4-the District Land Acquisition Officer, Ranchi to consider the objections of the petitioner after giving an opportunity of hearing to all the parties concerned preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
