02/ 20.04.2026: Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Balidih P.S. Case No. 05/2026 registered under sections 190, 191(2), 191(3),
126(2), 127(2), 117(2), 115(2), 109, 333, 76, 303(2) of BNS, 2023, pending
in the Court of learned S.D.J.M, Bokaro.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has
been falsely implicated in this case. He next submits that there is case and
counter case between the parties for that one title suit is also pending. On
these grounds, he submits that the petitioner may kindly be provided
privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsels for the State and informant oppose the
prayer and submit that allegations of assault are there and pursuant to that
injury has been received. Learned counsel for the State further submits that
the petitioner has two criminal antecedents and in view of that the
anticipatory bail of the petitioner may kindly be rejected.

5. Looking into contents of F.I.R, it transpires that there is direct
allegation of assault against the petitioner and pursuant to that injury has
been received. The allegation of outraging modesty of the wife of informant

is also there and petitioner has two criminal antecedents.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
