2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Jorapokhar P.S. Case No. 140 of 2024, registered for the offence under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the allegations are made of withdrawing Rs.1,50,000/-. He next submits that the co-accused, who has kept the cheque of the father of the informant, has been granted anticipatory bail in A.B.A. No.8072 of 2024 and other co-accused persons have also have been granted anticipatory bail A.B.A. No.260 of 2025 and A.B.A. No.8014 of 2024 and through the said cheque, different transactions have been taken place.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State has opposed the prayer and submits that the allegations are there of withdrawal of money by using forged Aadhar card.

5. Considering that the allegations are there against other co-accused persons of withdrawing the amount and informant himself has stated that his brother has misappropriated the cheque book of his father through Devendra Kumar Nonia, who has been granted anticipatory bail and other co-accused persons have also been granted anticipatory bail by this court and in that view of the matter, the petitioner, named above, is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
