02/10.04.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Musabani P.S. Case No. 10 of 2024 for the alleged offences registered under Section 498-A, 494 of the IPC, pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M. Ghatshila.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that false allegation is made against the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner happened to be the husband of the informant and there are a general and omnibus allegations of torture and taking away the children. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that petitioner happened to be husband.

5. Considering that the petitioner happened to be husband and the allegations are made of torture and taking away the children, however, the mode of torture is not disclosed in the FIR and in that view of the matter, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks and the learned Court shall release the petitioner on such terms and conditions or the sureties as the learned Court may deem fit and proper.
