Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Ormanjhi P.S. Case No.141 of 2025 (G.R. No. 3171 of 2025) registered for the offences punishable under sections 331(4)/305(a) of the B.N.S., 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is the third journey of the petitioner with the prayer for regular bail and the fresh ground is that in the meanwhile, the petitioner has been in custody for some more time. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. on the other hand vehemently opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioner has been in custody for some more time and the same is not a ground to review the prayer for regular bail which was rejected by a coordinate Bench of this Court. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner ought not to be admitted to bail.

Considering the serious nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that the prayer for regular bail has been rejected on merit and there is no fresh ground to be considered, this Court is of the view that this is not a fit case where the abovenamed petitioner be admitted to bail at this stage. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the abovenamed petitioner is

rejected for the same reasons as mentioned in the order dated
09.10.2025 in B.A. No. 9212 of 2025.
