Heard the learned counsel appearing for the appellant and the learned A.P.P. appearing for the State.

This application has been preferred by the appellant u/s 389(1) of the Cr.P.C. for grant of bail during the pendency of the appeal.

It has been stated by the learned counsel appearing for the appellant that the maximum sentence which has been imposed upon the appellant is R.I. for 7 years u/s 376 I.P.C. It has been stated that the appellant has remained in custody since 26.05.2016 and thus has completed half of the sentence.

Regard being had to the period of custody undergone by the appellant, the appellant is directed to be released on bail during pendency of this appeal, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court [Additional Sessions Judge-I, West Singhbhum at Chaibasa] in connection with Sessions Trial Case No. 164 of 2016.
