Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with S.T. No. 357 of 2024 arising out of Birsa Nagar P.S. Case No.30 of 2024 (G.R. No. 660 of 2024) registered for the offences punishable under sections 364A/302/201/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is the second journey of the petitioner with the prayer for regular bail and earlier the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner was rejected vide order dated 26.09.2024 in B.A. No. 6702 of 2024. It is next submitted that the fresh ground is that in the meanwhile four witnesses have been examined during the trial and out of which three have turned hostile and have not supported the case of the prosecution; even though they were put leading questions by the prosecution. It is further submitted that P.W.3 has deposed that the deceased went from his house with the petitioner. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the petitioner is a female. It is then submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 31.03.2024, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 15 of the bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that she will not annoy or

disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the abovenamed petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.S.J.-III, East Singhbhum, Jamshedpur, in connection with S.T. No. 357 of 2024 arising out of Birsa Nagar P.S. Case No.30 of 2024 (G.R. No. 660 of 2024) with the condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the trial of the case and will furnish her mobile number and a copy of her Aadhar Card in the court below with the undertaking that she will not change her mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that she will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
