**W.P. (PIL) No. 5899 of 2017**

By filing this W.P. (PIL), the petitioner has prayed for a direction upon the respondent authorities particularly respondent no.4-BCCL to ensure that respondent no.5- Kamladitya Construction Pvt. Ltd. to execute the work of maintenance of toilet constructed by respondent no.4-BCCL in various schools in the district of Bokaro, which is actually for the district of Dumka, as has been stated through an affidavit at later stage, as huge public money has been released in favour of respondent no.5 for construction of maintenance of toilets under the Scheme of respondent no. 4 and for issuance of further directions as it deem fit and proper by this Court.

On the last date of listing, the Court has directed the State to file up-to-date status report within a period of three weeks. The Status

Report has been filed. A supplementary affidavit, *inter alia*, stating that the present status is that out of 48 school toilets, electric connection has been provided in 32 schools' toilets by the JBVNL, as is evident from letter dated 08.04.2023 issued by the District Superintendent of Education-cum-Additional District Programme Officer, Dumka. It is further stated that 15 Bal Shramik schools as per the list enclosed at present are not functioning. Consequently, the main prayer of the petitioner has been redressed and since electricity supply connection have been provided in 32 schools' toilets, there is no need to adjourn the instant W.P. (PIL) any further and therefore, the instant W.P. (PIL) is disposed of with a direction to the State of Jharkhand to ensure that the Jharkhand Education Project Council take appropriate steps for maintenance of the toilets in the Schools, wherein, the electricity connection has been provided.

With such observation, W.P. (PIL) No. 5899 of 2017 stands disposed of.

Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.

Let a free copy of the order be handed over to the learned counsel for the State for early compliance.
