1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 25.11.2025 has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Sahibganj (M) P.S. Case No.91 of 2021, corresponding to G.R Case No.98 of 2026, registered for the offence under Sections 395, 397, 341, 504, 506 & 120B of the Indian Penal Code and cognizance has been taken under Section 384, 379 & 34 of the IPC, pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M, Sahibganj.
3. *It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.*
4. Earlier, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this applicant has been granted by this Court, vide order dated 06.12.2023 passed in A.B.A. No.8480 of 2023. As he could not surrender within the stipulated time, and as such, this applicant has been taken into custody. Thereafter, the present bail application has been filed seeking grant of regular bail.
5. Innocence has been claimed by the learned counsel for the applicant and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that the cognizance has already been taken under Sections 384, 379 & 34 of the IPC. Further, co-accused person namely, Bachchu Yadav has been granted bail by this Court, vide order dated 20.04.2023, passed in B.A. No.2207 of 2023. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.
6. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

7. Considering the fact that no injury has been reported, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M, Sahibganj in connection with Sahibganj (M) P.S. Case No.91 of 2021, corresponding to G.R Case No.98 of 2026, subject to condition that the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy/photocopies of his/her/their Aadhaar Card(s) and also submit his/her/their mobile number(s) before the learned Trial Court which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
