This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was suffering from severe Jaundice and is also suffering from heart disease. In support of the such contentions, various medical prescriptions have been brought on record.

A perusal of one of the prescriptions reveals that the petitioner was suffering from Jaundice on 09.06.2025 which by now must have been cured. So far as the heart ailment as insisted upon by the learned counsel for the petitioner is concerned, the report of the cardiologist reveals that there is no irregularity in the heart conditions of the petitioner.

None of the grounds which have been taken by the petitioner for exempting him to surrender in connection with Complaint Case No.2505 of 2018 are supported by the medical documents and considering the said fact, I am not inclined to allow this application which accordingly stands rejected.

I.A. No.9191 of 2025 stands rejected.
