The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for ignoring the defect No. 49 pointed out by the office.

Mr. V. P. Singh, learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner, submits that though the O.P. Nos. 1 & 3 to 5 were not the respondents in W.P.(C) No. 673/2025, however, they have been impleaded as opposite parties in the present contempt application in view of the fact that they have violated the direction as contained in paragraph 8 of the order dated 11.02.2025 passed in W.P.(C) No. 673/2025. Hence, the defect No. 49 pointed out by the office may be ignored.

So far as the defect No. 1 is concerned, learned Sr. counsel submits that the said defect has already been removed.

As regards the defect Nos. 4, 5 & 7, learned Sr. counsel undertakes that the same shall be removed in course of the day.

Having heard learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner, the defect No. 49 pointed out by the office is ignored for the present.

The present interlocutory application stands disposed of.
