as learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Jorapokhar P.S. Case No.80 of 2023, for the alleged offences
registered under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code pending in the
Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
during the course of investigation involvement of petitioner has
surfaced. He further submits that stolen motorcycle of this case was
recovered in Jogta P.S. Case No.18 of 2023 behind the house of co-
accused Rohit Kumar Bhuia and Rohit Kumar Bhuia is also made
accused in the present case and he has been granted anticipatory
bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ABA No.2089 of 2025. He
then submits that the name of the petitioner has come only on the

basis of that earlier case. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be granted.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the name of the petitioner has come on the basis of recovered motorcycle being Jogta P.S. Case No.18 of 2023.

5. Considering that the said motorcycle was recovered in Jogta P.S. Case No.18 of 2023 and the name of the petitioner in the present case surfaced in the course of investigation and co-accused Rohit Kumar Bhuia, who is also made accused in the present case, has been granted anticipatory bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the aforesaid ABA, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad in connection with Jorapokhar P.S. Case No.80 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
