It has been submitted by learned ASGI that Medium Density Fiber Boards 1282 in number are lying in Kuru P.S. He has submitted that the seizure list indicates that the truck as well as the contraband loaded on the truck have been seized.

However, there is no specific reply in the counter affidavit by the concerned respondents as to whether the 1282 pieces Medium Density Fiber Board have been seized or not. The matter is therefore adjourned to be listed 31.07.2026, by which time an affidavit must be filed by the learned ASGI indicating as to whether the Medium Density Fiber Boards 1282 in number have been seized or not as the same does not find place in the seizure list.
