1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody in connection with S.T. Case No. 30/2026 arising out of Ormanjhi P.S. Case No. 118/2025 for the offence registered under Sections 103(1), 85, 3(5) of BNS and Sections 3& 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, now said to have been pending in the court of learned Additional Judicial Commissioner-VII, Ranchi.

2. After some argument, when this Court was not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this bail application. However, the learned counsel submits that out of 13 charge-sheet witnesses, 9 have already been examined. The learned counsel has also submitted that the next date in the trial is 02.06.2026, which has been taken note of by the learned counsel for the opposite party-State.

3. Permission is accorded.

4. Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn.

5. The State is directed to ensure prompt production of the witnesses during trial.
6. Learned counsel for the State is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the Director, Prosecution as well as Superintendent of Police of the concerned district to ensure compliance.
