2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Gidhour P.S. Case No. 108 of 2025, registered for the offence under Sections 303(2), 317(2) and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chatra.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the alleged stolen articles have been recovered from the possession of the co-accused and that person has taken name of this petitioner. He next submits that apart from this, there is no allegation against the petitioner and the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent as disclosed in para 13 of the petition.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the State has opposed the prayer and submits that the name of the petitioner has come on the confessional statement.
5. Considering that the name of the petitioner has come on the confessional statement and the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent as disclosed in para 13 of the petition and the alleged articles have been recovered from the apprehended co-accused in that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender, he shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chatra, in connection with Gidhour P.S. Case No. 108 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
