2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Hazaribag Vigilance P.S. Case No.08 of 2025 for the alleged offences registered under Section 7(a) of Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 pending in the Court of learned Spl. Judge (Vigilance), Hazaribag.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has earlier moved before this Court in ABA No.6357 of 2025 which was dismissed. He further submits that there is no recovery and in view of fresh ground second anticipatory bail application has been filed.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the said anticipatory bail application was rejected on merit and there is no fresh ground to entertain the second

anticipatory bail application.

5. First anticipatory bail application of the petitioner has been rejected on merit in ABA No.6357 of 2025 and what has been argument that point was also available at the time of rejection of the said anticipatory bail. This second anticipatory bail application has been filed and no fresh ground has been argued to entertain the second anticipatory bail application.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.
