This criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed at the instance of the petitioner for restoration of Cr.M.P. No. 457 of 2026 to its original file.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Cr.M.P. No. 457 of 2026 was dismissed for non-compliance of the peremptory order of filing requisites.
