In this writ application, the petitioner has prayed for a direction
upon the concerned respondents to ensure that a proper investigation is
carried out in connection with Sidhgora P. S. Case No. 112 of 2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that despite filing
representation before the concerned authorities, the same has not been
acted upon.

Regard being had to the prayer made in this writ application, the
same stands disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh
representation before the respondent no. 3 within a period of two weeks
and if such representation is filed within the said period, the respondent
