and learned AC to AAG III for the State.

In this writ application, the petitioner has prayed for a direction
upon the concerned respondents to take action against the respondent
no. 4 for illegally detaining the father of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a
representation has been submitted before the respondent no. 3, but
according to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the same has not been
acted upon.

In view of the above, this writ application stands disposed of with
a direction to the petitioner to submit a fresh representation before the
respondent no. 3 addressing his grievance and if such representation is
filed within a period of two weeks, the respondent no. 3 shall look into
the matter and pass an appropriate order upon it expeditiously.
