1. The instant case has been filed for alleged deliberate and willful non-compliance of the order dated 08.10.2025 passed by this Court in W.P. (C) No. 4590 of 2025.
2. Pursuant to the order dated 17th April 2026, show cause has been filed.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the concerned opposite party has submitted that the reasoned order has been passed in terms of the order dated 08.10.2025, which is the subject matter of this case.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 08.10.2025, reasoned order has been passed, however, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected, and as such the contempt case may be disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to challenge the same before the appropriate forum.
5. No objection has been raised by the learned counsel appearing for the concerned opposite party.
6. Considering the fact that a reasoned order has been passed in terms of the order dated 08.10.2025, this Court is of the view that there is no need to proceed further in this contempt case.
7. Accordingly, the instant contempt case, being Cont. Case (Civil) No. 379 of 2026, is disposed of with liberty reserved to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 24.04.2026 passed by the Department of Mines & Geology, Government of Jharkhand (appended as Annexure-A to the show cause filed by the opposite party), if the petitioner so wishes.
