1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The instant writ application has been preferred by the petitioners for the following reliefs;

(i) For quashing of Clause 6 of Resolution No.1093, dated 21.02.2026 (Annexure-8) issued under the Secretary, Government of Jharkhand, whereby, after due consideration, the State Government has decided the cut-off dates for calculation of maximum age limit shall be 01.08.2022 pursuant to Jharkhand Combined Civil Services Competitive Examination, 2025, which is applicable for candidates of all categories which is out & out illegal, arbitrary & unreasonable, particularly in view of the fact that Rule - 4 (i) of the Jharkhand Combined Civil Services Examination, 2021, since the examination is not being conducted every year as mandate in the said Rule and considering the same, the respondent-State has given the age relaxation in last Civil Services Examination pursuant to Advertisement No. 01 of 2021 the cut-off date for the calculation of upper age limit was 01.08.2016 and pursuant to Advertisement No.01 of 2024, which was conducted in the year 2024 by treating the cut-off date for the calculation of upper age limit as 01.08.2017.

(ii) To hold and declare the Resolution No. 1093, dated 21.02.2026 (Annexure-8) as Ultra-Vires to Jharkhand Combined Civil Services Examination, 2021 as well as Article 14 of the Constitution of India since the said decision of the State Government has denied the legitimate expectation of aspirants at large and also the same is arbitrary and unfair.

(iii) In consequent thereof, the respondent-State be directed to publish a fresh Resolution by relaxing the

cut-off dates for calculation of maximum age limit as 01.08.2018.

INTERIM PRAYER

(iv) During pendency of the writ petition, the operation, implementation and execution of the Resolution No.1093, dated 21.02.2026 (Annexure-8) passed by the Department of Personnel, Administrative Reforms and Rajbhasa, Government of Jharkhand may be stayed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submits that the issue involved in this writ application is squarely covered by the judgment rendered in L.P.A. No. 202 of 2026 along with analogous cases.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that it is true that the issues are squarely covered by the aforesaid judgment, but the fact remains that the aforesaid judgment is against the petitioner.

5. Having regard to the aforesaid fact and after going through the judgment, it appears that the same is decided against the petitioners.

6. Having regard to the above no relief can be granted to the petitioner; accordingly, the instant writ application stands rejected. Pending I.A.s if any also stands disposed of.
